## UNIVERSAL CREDIT ..... What you need to know

Full Service Universal Credit is coming to Glasgow.  
In the North East of the City this will happen on:

**31<sup>st</sup> October 2018 - Springburn Jobcentre**

**5<sup>th</sup> December 2018 - Shettleston Jobcentre**

After these dates, if you need to make a NEW claim for any of the Benefits below you will need to claim Universal Credit.

### Universal Credit will replace the six working-age benefits:

- Income-based jobseeker's allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Income support
- Child tax credits
- Working tax credits
- Housing benefit

You will need to complete your application online.
