1.	Welcome & Apologies	
	Ann welcomed all present to the meeting and welcomed Aidan to his first meeting as Modern Apprentice for the North East Hubcap, hosted by St Pauls Youth Forum.	
2.	Previous Minutes	
	The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.	
3.	Local Updates	
	<p><u>St Paul's Youth Forum</u> – Neil informed the group that the Community Meal has started back and that although it's the end of the growing season; they have a 'grow your own Christmas dinner' program running. Halloween parties have been held recently and Bolt FM continues to run well. Also, staff and young people were in London recently as they were nominated for a 'Ground Works' Award which was a great experience.</p> <p><u>YoMo</u> – James informed the group that the Health Champions have now been recruited and it is going really well. YoMo are also recruiting for Youth Grant makers for the Youth Bank programme.</p> <p><u>Glasgow Life</u> – The Glasgow Life Panto will take place again this year and Donald will send information out through the network to advertise this. He also informed the group that a young person involved in Glasgow Life, who is a young MSP, was named as one of the top 30 influential young people in Scotland.</p> <p><u>Glasgow Sport</u> – Gemma informed the group that there are plans in place for a Christmas party on Saturday 16th December and asked if anyone else would like to be involved with this or would be able to support this. 	<p>suggested that Glasgow Sport could link in with the Winterfest programme that is running at Easterhouse from the end of November.</p> <p><u>FARE</u> – Staff have been co-ordinating Halloween and Firework events and they are planning their Christmas events and are also supporting the Winterfest programme.</p> <p><u>Connect</u> – Young people are working towards their Christmas shows and are involved in Winterfest. Young people within Calvey are involved in a Christmas cooking programme.</p> <p><u>Health Improvement</u> – Ann informed the group that there is upcoming training on SMHFA and Healthy Young Lives. Ann is delivering an Aye Mind workshop at the National Youth Work Conference this month and it will be a good opportunity to raise the profile of Aye Mind.</p> <p><u>PEEK</u> – Michaela informed the group that they were successful in winning an award at the Ground works ceremony in London.</p>	
4.	Membership Activity

6.	Assets Mapping Update	
	Health Improvement staff have collated this information and invited the MA's to come along to this session. However, the Chairs are now unclear on what the best format is to present this information. Neil asked if there was a possibility to use money from Hubcaps to create something digital to capture this data. Neil will feed this back to the Strategic Group.	NY

8.	Hubcap Funding	
	Chris informed the group that £60k was allocated to fund the MA's and this now leaves £6700 per hubcap, in addition to their £2k for community events. Aidan suggested that he would like to do some video editing workshops with young people which would involve training and purchasing equipment. Aidan and Neil will look at hubcap application for funding. Ann informed Aidan that she attended a course organised by Prince Trust which was beneficial called 'Digitally Agile Community Learning and Development (DACDL)' and suggested Aidan look into this too. James also informed the group there is also 'Youth training for Films' based at Trongate which may be of interest.	CK AD NY

9.	Youth Consultancy Task Force	
	Chris informed the group that Alan (ToonSpeak) has six young people now able to deliver workshops/consultations with the MA's and with youth projects. There will be minimal costs involved in delivering this training.	
10.	PEF Event	
	The Chairs and Reps have been invited to attend the 'Pupil Equity Fund' event at Lochend High School tomorrow night which is being organised by Education staff. The document for the Hubcaps has been collated and will be available for Education staff on the night. The event will take the format of a 'World Café' event where the Hubcaps will have the opportunity to talk about their services in each area.

	Ann informed the group that there is currently a national campaign on ageing purchasing called #notafavour and there are resource packs available through ASH Scotland. Red Cross have two upcoming training sessions on 'Everyday First Aid' and Drugs & Alcohol. There is also a course on 'Stigma and Migration' and Ann will share this with the network. Gemma informed the group that the European Championships will be held in Glasgow in August and would like to encourage a partnership approach to this to ensure that venues in Easterhouse and Crown Point are utilised for sports that are accessible for all.
